Important results: Projects Erasmus+



EduSenNet - Educational Senior Network: implemented research on the methodology of learning, focused on the motivation, barriers and needs of seniors (4,000), collection of good practices.

SELID – Seniors Learning in the Digital Society: improving computer literacy, extending learning opportunities in Digital technologies, ICT, accessible apps, online courses, best practices for seniors' learning (4,800 seniors involved in 2019-2022).

GENEDUinENVIRO: environmental learning for seniors since 2023, innovative practices, care of own environment, saving electricity, community health, excursions: Danubiana Gallery, National parks...



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
