Target group

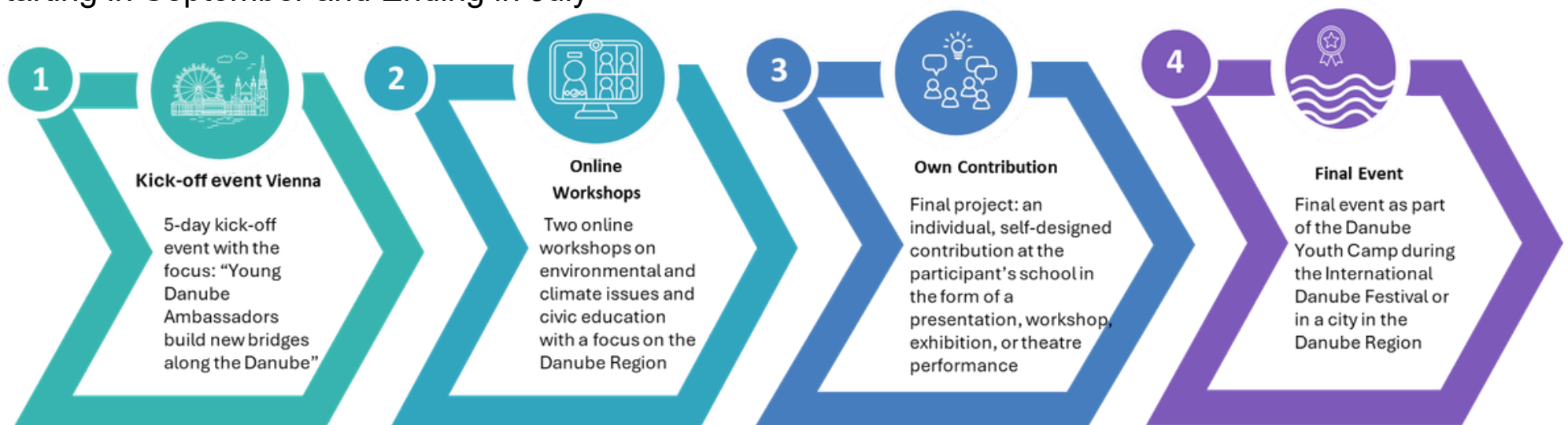
motivated secondary school students from the Danube Region who are at least 16 years old and possess very good German language skills.
